Welcome to worship here at Zion on this Fourth Sunday of Advent – we are glad you're here! Cradle and cross are inextricably connected on the fourth Sunday of Advent. Between a lovely tribute to the little town of Bethlehem and Mary's magnificent song of praise, the letter to the Hebrews reminds us in no uncertain terms that Christ's advent is for "the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all." It is the kind of tension in which the church always lives as when in holy communion—with high delight—"we proclaim the Lord's death."

In this season of light, let us go before God and confess how our words and actions contribute to the shadows instead of adding to the light. [Silence for reflection] God of Love and Light,





then the rest of his kindred shall return

to the people of Israel.

SECOND READING Hebrews 10:5-10

- ⁵ Consequently, when Christ came into the world, he said,
 - "Sacrifices and offerings you have not desired,
 - but a body you have prepared for me;
 - ⁶ in burnt offerings and sin offerings you have taken no pleasure.
 - ⁷Then I said, 'See, God, I have come to do your will, O God'
 - (in the scroll of the book it is written of me)."
- ⁸ When he said above, "You have neither desired nor taken pleasure in sacrifices and offerings and burnt offerings and sin offerings" (these are offered according to the law), ⁹ then he added, "See, I have come to do your will." He abolishes the first in order to establish the second. ¹⁰ And it is by God's will that we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

The holy gospel according to Luke.


Glory to you, O Lord.

+ NICENE CREED

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen, and unseen.



+ INVITATION TO COMMUNION


God feeds us with tender mercy. Come to the table.

If you wish to receive grape juice rather than wine, please indicate this preference by approaching the communion server with your hand out and palm down. The grape juice is located in the center ring of the communion tray. All who believe in Christ as Lord and Savior, young and old, are welcome at this feast.


